

COVID-19 Prevention

[Notice] New Access Control & Temperature Measurement Regulations from Jun. 22

According to CDC, the pandemic of COVID-19 has been subsiding in Taiwan recently. NCCU accordingly announced the latest regulations of access control and temperature measure effective from Jun. 22 as below.

1. Real-name system for visitors' entry

Visitors are allowed to enter NCCU through the **main gate** and **back gate** (signatures needed). However, vehicles of visitors are still forbidden to enter NCCU campus.

2. Sports facilities & venues reopen for visitors

Gymnasium and **sports facilities** (swimming pool, tennis court and outdoor sports facilities) will be reopen for visitors.

3. Temperature measurement check points

Except for the 4 temperature check points at the following entrances: **main gate, back gate, entrances at east and west wings**, no additional temperature checkpoint is required upon entering buildings on NCCU campus.

4. Continuous practices for pandemic prevention

- Wearing masks
- Sanitizing hands
- Maintaining social distancing (when masks are not worn)
- Self-health care such as measuring temperature on a daily basis
