Course Design	NCCU provides fixed Program with 4-week Mandarin class and 8 English-taught academic intensive courses in the fields of Management, Social Sciences, and Humanities, focusing on the aspects of Taiwan, China, and East Asia.	Study Abroad: NCCU design class, language learning and excursions according to the requirements provided by partner schools. Education Abroad: lectures and staff from partner school + venues, excursions or culture classes provided by NCCU.
Course selection	Participants can arrange their course according to their demands and the fee will be different regarding their choices : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 4-week Chinese Language Study Program (no excursion) • 4-week English-taught Program (at least 2 courses, including excursion) • 4-week Chinese Language Study with 1 or 2 English-taught courses (no excursion) 	Students should attend every class once they enroll in the program and there will be no refund if they choose to skip any course or excursion.
